A WORD FROM THE PASTOR

Disciples, not Clones

Mathātueo: (Greek), Disciple, to be a disciple or follower of another's doctrine. As used in Matthew 28:19. "Go and make disciples of all nations..."

Clone: (English) (After ignoring more correct and precise definitions in favor of popular use) An exact copy.

I don't think there's a Bible word equivalent to clone. If there was, it wouldn't be disciple. A

disciple is one who follows another closely and tries to learn from Him. The twelve, eventually called Apostles, were first called Disciples.

Two of the original disciples, John and Andrew, were apparently on the prowl for someone worthy of following. Both were followers of John the Baptist, until he pointed them to Jesus, and they immediately (and literally) began following Him (Jn 1:35-40) The others were apparently happily going about their own business when they encountered Jesus. Most people were probably surprised to find these men suddenly becoming disciples.

Matthew 28:19 tells us to go make disciples. In other passages, while not using the word, Paul tells us to be disciples. In 1 Cor 4:16, he says simply, "Be imitators of me." Later in the same book he writes, "Be imitators of me, just as I also am of Christ" (1 Cor 11:1). To the Philippians he wrote, "Whatever you have learned or received or heard from me, or seen in me—put it into practice" (Phil 4:9).

To disciple someone is to take them under your wing and help them learn how to live the Christian life. To be disciples is to see someone who you think is living a good Christian life, and try to learn from them.

But that does not mean to become a clone of the person you are learning from, or to make a clone of the person you are discipling.

Ephesians 2:10 has a powerful verse with a terrific word for you. "For we are His workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand so

we could walk in them." That word, 'workmanship,' is one to hang on. That word comes from a time long before Henry Ford developed the assembly line. You are not a mass-produced item, one like so many other identical things doing the same things.

God looked at what He wanted done, and crafted someone to do that thing. You. You are custom-built according to God's purpose. You can't be someone else, and you're not supposed to be someone else. You are supposed to be the best version of you that you can be. Sometimes that means learning from and following the example of others.

I like the word 'emulate.' I don't think you'll ever arrive. Almost 50 years of Christianity and I haven't. And you probably will reach the point you don't have a human discipler any more. But you will never run out of people to emulate. You get to pick and choose things you would like to add to your tool box. Not bouncing from leader to leader trying to be a clone. But learning from many, finding out how to be a better disciple.


